



The Top **Generic** Substitutions to **Save Money**

Pharmaceutical ingredient costs are soaring, consuming resources needed for other areas of medical care. Physicians are under pressure from pharmaceutical companies and patients to prescribe the newest brand name medications. Employers are wondering how they will be able to continue to fund these increases.

Wonder what you can do to help?

Generics are one way to curb the growth in drug costs and you only need to remember a few basic substitutions.

Listed right are the top substitutions that would make the biggest cost difference. The specific drugs listed reflect the Avera Health Plans formulary, but the most important categories to remember include PPIs, statins, COX2s and antidepressants. If you simply remember to start with Omeprazole, Lovastatin, Ibuprophen and Fluoxetine, you have made a big difference already. While they may not be right for every patient, these substitutions will work for the majority of patients.

Provider **UPDATES**

Reappointment

One of the most rigorous standards NCQA holds health plans accountable for is the credentialing and recredentialing process for selecting and evaluating the practitioners who practice within its delivery system. When you contracted with Avera Health Plans, you provided the plan with the information necessary for initial credentialing. According to NCQA standards, a recredentialing process must be undertaken by the plan at regular intervals to verify credentialing information that may change over time.

With the feedback we have received from our providers, we have attempted to streamline the recredentialing process. Providers will be sent a recredentialing profile based on the information provided at initial credentialing. The profile must be reviewed and updated (if necessary) and the provider must complete two pages of disclosure information that is required to be updated at recredentialing. The schedule of recredentialing is based upon providers' birthdates and completed every two years as required by NCQA.

What is a "Site Review"?

The "Site Review" assesses the quality of the facility where care is provided. This review helps to assure the members of Avera Health Plans (AHP) of physical accessibility and adequate examination and waiting areas at each office site. AHP also assesses the adequacy of appointments and the medical/treatment records practices. This systematic assessment of standards is important to ensure the quality of patient care.

NCQA requires that when performance thresholds are not met, the office must develop a Performance Improvement Plan with a follow-up visit to be done in six months.

If a practitioner has an office located in an accredited facility, AHP will accept a copy of the survey report in lieu of its own site visit. The report is to include the practitioner's office and must have been performed within the past two years. Also, it must meet the quality assessment standards set forth by AHP.

"Site Review" is only for Primary Care Physicians, OB/Gyns and Behavioral Health sites. A representative of AHP will make arrangements for the 30 to 45 minute visit. The "Site Review" does not impact your participation status with AHP; rather it is a measure for AHP to help ensure adequate care for its members.

Coding & BILLING

E&M Profiles

Do you wonder how you compare with other physicians in your billing practices?

Avera Health Plans (AHP) will be sending out information to individual providers allowing them to see how their E&M coding practices compare to

their peers. The graphs will include new and established patient encounters and will be broken down into specific E&M codes.

The goal of providing this information is to encourage appropriate billing and reimbursement of services. AHP is also looking at other useful information to provide to providers about their practices. Information on prescribing practices and care patterns compared to peer groups is also on the way. Watch for it in the coming months.

New Look for EOB/EOP Coming Soon

Avera Health Plans (AHP), together with Advanced Business Fulfillment (ABF) is redesigning our Explanation of Benefits (EOB) and Explanation of Payments (EOP). Our goal is to produce documents that are easy to read and understand for both members and providers.

With this new partnership, AHP will have the ability to link from our website back to ABF's database of pdf images. Through the provider inquiry system, providers will be able to check claim status and view or reprint the exact images of past EOPs. In addition, our members will have the option of receiving their EOBs electronically via e-mail instead of through the U.S. Mail.

The new EOBs and EOPs are currently in the design phase. Watch for inserts in our next mailing detailing the new look and explaining "How to Read Your New EOB/EOP."

Transmission of the HIPAA Standard 835–Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) to Begin Soon

Avera Health Plans (AHP) is in the final implementation process for system set ups to allow transmission of HIPAA compliant 835–ERAs to our providers. Providers who wish to receive the 835–ERA in place of our standard paper EOP will need to contact AHP Network Services.

Each provider will be supplied with access to our FTP server URL address. A User ID and Password will be necessary to log into the FTP server for the retrieval of 835-ERA files. Providers will need PGP encryption/decryption software applications in order to receive an 835-ERA. AHP will furnish a PGP encryption/decryption key for the purposes of authentication. This process will ensure all private health information is protected from unauthorized persons.

Moving to an electronic standard 835-ERA environment means implementing the standardized EOB/EOP message codes mandated by the Federal Government. Standardization of these message codes will replace today's EOB/EOP messages. AHP has designed a crosswalk document for ease of transition and it will be available to all providers through the AHP Provider Manual.

Durable Medical Equipment Benefit for 2005

Many Avera Health Plans (AHP) Commercial Products will experience a benefit change to Durable Medical Equipment (DME) in 2005. This change will limit the 2005 DME benefit to a \$1,000 yearly paid maximum. The previous DME benefit was 'Rental up to Purchase Price.' In addition to this change, some language changes will be made to the Certificate of Coverage in order to clarify benefits. All changes will be effective as of January 1, 2005 for both current and new groups with AHP.
